Patient **MUST** be interested in Monoclonal Antibody treatment

Patient **MUST** meet ALL of the following:

- Within 4 days of a Positive COVID test
- Positive Covid-19 test with mild/moderate disease
- ≥ 12 years old or greater
- Weight ≥ 40 kg
- Symptoms started within the last 10 days
- Is **NOT** an inpatient
- Does **NOT** require oxygen due to COVID-19

AND at least one of the below:

- Pregnant
- Body mass index (BMI) ≥ 25 : Height: _____ Weight: _____ BMI: _____
- Chronic kidney disease
- Diabetes
- Immunosuppressive disease: Specify: _____
- Currently receiving immunosuppressive treatment: Specify: _____
- ≥ 65 years of age
- Are ≥ 55 years of age **AND** have
 - Cardiovascular disease, OR
 - Hypertension, OR
 - Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease/other chronic respiratory disease
- 12-17 years of age **AND** have
 - BMI ≥ 85 th percentile for their age and gender based on CDC growth charts, <https://www.cdc.gov/growthcharts/clinicalcharts.htm> OR,
 - Sickle cell disease, OR
 - Congenital or acquired heart disease, OR
 - Neurodevelopmental disorders, for example, cerebral palsy, or a medical-related technological dependence, for example, tracheostomy, gastrostomy, or positive pressure ventilation (not related to COVID-19), OR
 - Asthma, reactive airway or other chronic respiratory disease that requires daily medication for control
- Treatment benefits outweigh the risks to patient.
